# **#775 WATER TONIFY** (Strengthen Bones)

The Water Element is correlated to our inner reserves, strength, and confidence. The energy to rest and conduct the healing processes is part of this element. The grit or will power stems from Water, as does the ability to go with the flow. The Chinese believe that the genetic traits of our parents are inherited via the Water Element. Excesses or deficiencies result in imbalances characterized by inability to accomplish goals and be restricted in life by fears.

The Water Element supports the health of bones, kidneys, spleen, digestive system, and connective tissues. The bone matrix is an aspect of the Water Element, and is the foundation of healthy bones. This formula helps the body to use its own resources to stay healthy, supports healthy and thick hair and smooth skin, and supports normal healthy sex functions for men and women. Emotionally, the Water Element supports the deep well of conserved energy reserves required to carry a person through life. In Chinese Medicine it is said to boost the essence, enrich the kidneys and nourish yin.

The kidneys and urinary bladder are the organs of the Water Element. The kidneys store the essence for the entire body, and are responsible for growth, development, and reproduction; produces the marrow to fill the brain and maintains water metabolism. The ancient Chinese state that the kidneys are the root of the congenital constitution. The water element is weakened through aging, over taxation, inadequate rest and relaxation, trauma (surgeries, accidents), numerous pregnancies, late life pregnancies, excessive sex, alcoholism, various drugs/medications. Essence is also depleted due to lack of daily support with proper vitamins, nutrients, water, clean air, and moderate exercise.

## **▼ KEY COMPONENTS**

- Eucommia Eucommia ulmoides. Du Zhong. Is strongly associated with the kidneys and to a lesser extent with the liver. In Chinese medicine, the kidneys store jing. Jing is an essential life source and associated with whole body growth and development, as well as normal sexual and reproductive functioning. The kidney and liver jing also affects the bones, ligaments, and tendons.
- Achyranthes (Root) Huai Niu Xi. Contains saponins.
   Supports normal kidney and water processes.
- Rehmannia Dihuang. Rich in amino acids, Vitamins (A, B, C), cerebroside, melittoside, dammelittoside, and rehmaglitin, rehmannia is known as a blood tonic and purifier thanks to its astringent properties provided by the chemical content. A kidney yin tonic also supportive of the kidneys' neighboring endocrine glands, the adrenals.
- Glossy Privet (Fruit) Ligustrum lucidum. Cited in the Divine Husband's Materia Medica in 190 CBE, this cooling, yin-supportive fruit contains tanins; oleanolic, betulinic, and urosolic acids; and saponins. Clears heat and emotional tension.
- Teasel (Fruit) Dipsacus fullonum. Affiliated with the Liver and Kidney meridians, and has bitter, pungent and warm properties. Its functions are to tonify the liver and kidneys, promote blood circulation, and strengthen the bones and tendons.
- Angelica (Root) A Native American herb associated with supporting the body's normal blood purification processes including liver, gall bladder and kidney activities.
- Astragalus (Root) Radix astragali. Huang Qi. An adaptogen and tonifying (bu fa) factor said to lend strength (qi) to normal tissue function. Provides

protective polysaccharides and processes dampness.

- Barrenwort (Leaves) Epimedium. Yin Yang Huo. Enhancer
  of kidney ch'i. Historic use includes supporting normal erectile
  processes and modern science finds that it supports nitric oxide
  metabolic activity. Contains icariin supportive of normal bone
  osteoblast processes.
- Sweetgum (Fruit) Fructus liquidambaris. Lu Lu Tong. Used to support blood flow, kidneys, bladder, and urination.
