## KEY INDICATIONS

- Gastrointestinal irritation or mucosal inflammation
- Burns, sunburn, and skin irritation (topical application)
- Cuts, abrasions, and minor wound care
- Inflamed or irritated skin conditions

- Occasional constipation or sluggish bowel motility

## HOW IT WORKS

*Aloe vera* (inner leaf liquid) supplies polysaccharides and mucilaginous compounds that interact with epithelial tissues to support hydration, mucosal barrier integrity, and tissue repair signaling. These compounds help calm inflammatory pathways within skin and gastrointestinal linings while supporting epithelial regeneration. As a topical application it forms a protective layer that helps maintain moisture balance and promotes normal cellular repair processes in irritated or damaged tissues.

## CLINICAL PEARLS

- Apply topically for poison ivy; allow to dry on area.
- Use 4 oz with **C - Colon** for constipation.
- Use with **MucosaGenic** for leaky gut repair.
- Use therapeutic dosing for acute mucosal irritation or active symptoms.
- Safe for children when used in appropriate amounts; adjust dosing based on clinical presentation.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Topical dose: Apply full strength externally as needed

**Aloe vera Gel (inner leaf):** Provides mucopolysaccharides and soothing plant compounds that support epithelial tissue hydration, promote mucosal barrier integrity, and assist normal repair processes in skin and gastrointestinal tissues.
